

Notice to League Bowlers and Customers:

We are committed to keeping our business running, while also ensuring the safety of our team members and our patrons. The coronavirus situation is evolving, and while we do not know what is coming next, we want you to be fully aware of and confident in our preparation to work within this higher-risk environment.

We have always made it our priority to provide a clean and friendly environment for our customers. With the recent recommendations from government health official's we have increased our cleaning frequency and will exercise social distancing to the best of our ability when placing customers on lanes. We clean tables and all contact surfaces after every group leaves. Additionally, we spray all bowling shoes with disinfectant any time they pass across the counter and we clean bowling balls with alcohol regularly.

We are still open with modified hours and will be exercising social distancing by having a minimum of one lane between all recreational open bowling groups, which equates to roughly 6 to 8 feet in between all groups. Food and beverage service, including alcoholic beverages will remain open and available to all guests according to our Governor's Executive Orders announced and released throughout the day on Tuesday. Please refer to our website for any modification in our hours of operation as well as any updates in our policy as this situation evolves.

Due to all of our leagues having members in the category that government officials have deemed to be at-risk, and the close quarters that leagues function in, effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, The Alley at Southshore and Brandon Crossroads Bowl will temporarily suspend leagues for 2 weeks. We will continue to monitor the situation and although at this time we have not discussed, and it is not possible at this time, to know how this will impact the remainder of the league season for each of our leagues. Our top priority is and shall remain for the health and safety of our guests and employees. We will closely monitor the situation and adapt as the information changes/gets updated, and we will continue to update information as we have it available.
